

Professional Educator Behaviours



Quality Care

- I will demonstrate Quality Care by using positive language with Children, engaging them in meaningful conversation that encourages them to participate in activities.
- I will demonstrate Quality Care through genuine understanding of children's learning and development and documenting children's learning daily to StoryPark.
- I will positively communicate children's learning and wellbeing to their parents through conversations, discussions, emails, centre displays and children's StoryPark profile.
- I will demonstrate Quality Care by respecting and responding to each child's individual needs and family's needs.
- I will demonstrate Quality Care by taking responsibility for the health and safety of all children in my Care.

Empathy

- I will demonstrate Empathy by being professional, respectful, and supportive towards all families, children, visitors and other educators.
- I will always consider the impact of the way I communicate.

Development

- I will demonstrate Development by taking the time to prepare well in advance in accordance to EYLF, NQF, and relevant regulations to ensure my activities meet and maximise the children's learning and development.
- I will always challenge my skills, knowledge and experience by working collaboratively with other professionals, and taking initiative to seek opportunities for further training and professional development.

Enthusiasm

- I will demonstrate Enthusiasm by coming to work with a positive attitude and being professional in my role.
- I will demonstrate Enthusiasm by providing a service to "parents that they do not realise they want"

- I will demonstrate a positive attitude and work collaboratively with my team to find solutions to challenging situations

Partnership

- I will demonstrate Partnership by engaging with families, visitors, and educators in a proactive and positive manner.
- I will demonstrate Partnership by ensuring a smooth transition upon arrival and departure of all Children.

Non-negotiable behaviours:

- Demonstrating a negative attitude, negative behaviour and engaging in negative communications with others
- Demonstrating an unwillingness to perform their professional duties as an educator
- Demonstrating a lack of teamwork and unwillingness to support colleagues
- Demonstrating a lack of proactive attitude towards challenging situations/problems.
- Blaming others, making excuses and not demonstrating accountability for own actions
- Not calling out unacceptable behaviour or actions of others
